## White Wines

### El Molturo Blanco

A light, crisp and dry white, from the sun-drenched vineyards of Spain.

### Alfredini, Pinot Grigio, Veneto, Italy

The Italians know who to make a good Pinot – light, dry and lemony with a touch of pear.

### Big Bombora, Chardonnay, Australia

Fresh tropical fruit and a soft and well-rounded mouthfeel.

### Stonebuck Sauvignon Blanc, South Africa

A vivid palate of green fruit, tropical guava and herbaceous notes.

### Fathoms, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand

A classy Marlborough Sauvignon, from a top producer. Incredible aromatics of grapefruit, white peach and elderflower, and passionfruit on the palate. Delicious!

### Chablis, Cape St Martin Burgundy, France

A Old World classic. Delicate, wonderfully balanced, with a long, clean finish.

### Sancerre Blanc, Berthier, Loire, France

The spiritual home of Sauvignon Blanc. Grapefruit and gooseberry, with hints of lime, chalk and flint.

## Rosé

### Blushmore Zinfandel Rosé, Italy

A medium sweet rosé with flavours of strawberry and cream.

### Pinot Grigio Rosé, Le Colline di San Giorgio, Italy

A dry, classy Rosé, made with grapes left to get sunburnt in the autumn sun.

### Terres de Berne Rosé, South of France

In a striking square edged bottle, this classy Provence rosé is delicate and elegant with fresh summer fruits and tropical suggestions of mango.

## Red Wines

### Michel Servin Rouge, French Regions

A medium bodied and fruity red, with blackcurrant and plum flavours.

### La Tierra Rocosa, Merlot, Central Valley, Chile

Soft and smooth, with a hit of plum and eucalyptus.

### Five Foot Track, Shiraz, South Eastern Australia

Like all good Aussie Shiraz, this delivers lashings of ripe black fruit and a spicy note of black pepper.

### Beauté du Sud, Malbec, South France

The popularity of Malbec shows no sign of slowing. Try this juicy, smooth number to see why.

### Rioja Reserva, Barón de Ebro, Rioja, Spain

A very special Rioja, aged in oak for 18 months, from the stellar 2010 vintage.

### Pinot Noir, Domaine de Valmoissine, Louis Latour, South France

From a producer steeped in history, this classy red has cherry notes, with a touch of vanilla.

### Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Les Puits Neuf, Rhône Valley, France

An old-world classic from the Rhone. Big, spicy, bold and complex. Go on, treat yourself

## Sparkling Wine & Champagne

### Prosecco, Romeo & Juliet, Treviso, Pasqua, Italy

Everything you would want in a Prosecco, floral notes, peachy with a golden apple note.

### J de Telmont Grande Réserve, Champagne, France

From a small family owned champagne house, an award winning traditional style, has notes of brioche and bruised apple.
